

Angeles National Golf Club Fall Maintenance 2026

Dear Valued Patron,

With fall just around the corner, here are some updates on upcoming golf course maintenance activities scheduled for September.

Fall Overseed – Course Closed September 8th & 9th

To provide the best playing conditions for the fall/winter season, ANGC has elected to continue overseeding tees, collars, aprons and green surrounds.

What to expect:

- Leading up to Overseed, some prep work such as light Vert cutting and aeration in areas to be seeded- This will aid in soil penetration and improve soil conditions for new growth
- Seeded areas will be considered Ground Under Repair.
- To maintain adequate moisture watering windows will be implemented until 9/18/26
- Driving Range Tee – Mats only until 9/24/2026

Turf Renovations – September 21st-30th

The turf renovation project will include tee resurfacing on Holes 1 and 5, as well as a collar extension on Hole 1.

What to expect:

- Hole 1 Black/Blue/White Tees – existing turf will be stripped, tee roto tilled, laser leveled and resodded. Existing flagstone will be removed to increase tee area. Temporary tees will be utilized for two weeks following sod install.
- Hole 1 Green Collar extension – existing turf will be stripped, soil imported to raise collar and surrounding rough. The goal is to remove the severe slope and correct the bare spot behind the green.
- Hole 5 Blue/White Tees – existing turf will be stripped, tee roto tilled, laser leveled and resodded. This renovation coincides with recent tree removals to improve turf quality. Temporary tees will be utilized for two weeks following sod install

WetJect Sand Injection – October 5th- 14th

The sand injection system will be utilized this fall to continue conditioning our greens. The WetJect system aerates and injects sand into the soil profile in one pass. This practice provides many benefits such as dilution of organic matter, reduced compaction and improved drainage.

What to expect:

- During this time 3-4 greens will be completed each day
- Aeration holes and light top-dress sand will be noticeable
- Minimal disruption to golfers and ball roll
- Best of all healthier Greens!
